Updated In-Person Worship Recommendations

The following excerpt from the Governor’s recent directive notes CDC and State guidance moving forward:

NCDHHS will continue to have strong public health recommendations for individuals to continue to protect one another until more people are vaccinated. People who are not vaccinated should wear a mask and maintain distance in all indoor public settings and in outdoor settings when they can't maintain six feet of distance.

In response to this, the Worship Committee has agreed on the following guidelines:

All individuals entering the Church should wear a mask until they are seated and socially distanced from others. Once seated everyone may then remove their mask. We would ask that you wear your mask if you must leave your seat.

Congregational hymns may return to our worship service. Those attendees who are not fully vaccinated are asked to wear their mask during the singing of hymns. Those fully vaccinated may remain unmasked.

Fully vaccinated choir members may come together to practice and perform during the morning service, if they so desire.

Hopefully, these changes are just a first step as we begin our return to normal worship. Please let members of the Worship Committee know if you have any questions or concerns.

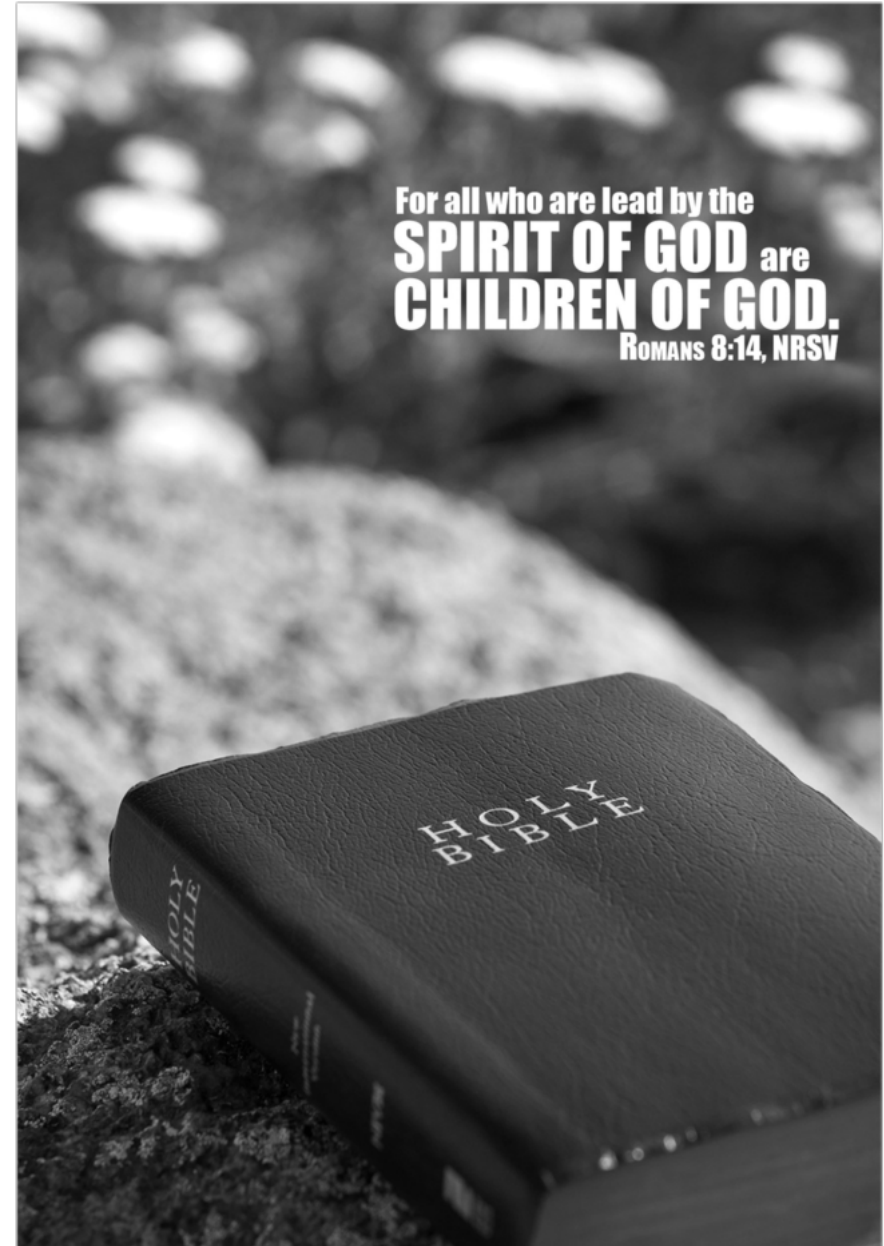
