There is a Peace Lilly in my office a friend gave me a few Pastor's months ago. So far, I have managed to keep it looking good. I moved it several times to find the best place for light. I water it weekly to keep it green and lush. Unfortunately, last week as I took time away to spend with Jared and to conduct a wedding, the plant

grew thirsty and dry. When I came into the office yesterday, it was drooped, and its flowers were brown. I watered it and waited a few hours, but nothing happened. It remained looking lifeless and spent. I watered it again toward the end of the day and left it to sit overnight. This morning I was happy to see the Lily looking perky and full of life. I am so glad I was patient and didn't give up too quickly; I am thankful I didn't throw it away.

This flower reminds me so much of how we must constantly tend to faith. To stay strong in the Lord we must be constantly watered and cared for. We grow weak and droopy when we don't attend to feeding our inner spirit with Living Water. Our foliage turns brown and our beauty fades when we don't pay attention to keeping our hearts on Jesus. Too often when we neglect faith, and then we need it most, it is like a dried-up Peace Lilly looking parched and ugly, nearly dead, and useless.

The thing is, God does not want our faith to die. God does not want us to lose our vitality. God wants our faith to remain strong, ready at a moment's notice to grant us shade and comfort when we need it. Like the Peace Lilly, our faith droops when we are not watering it. Like the Peace Lilly, the evidence of our neglect is noticeable. Still, the life of the Spirit remains in us. God does not take away God's love for us. There is always potential in the Christian's heart that with proper watering, renewal, and rededication, we will flourish and grow again. Of course, like the Lilly, it may not happen with one watering, and it may not happen in a short time. Sometimes we must return to the well numerous times depending on how dry we have allowed our hearts to become; often it takes time to be restored to the place where we once were.

As I cut the dead flowers from the Lilly, I was reminded again of Jesus' words on pruning (see John 15:2). Evidence of neglect had to be dealt with. The plant recovered but not without having to go through a time of cutting away those flowers that were brown and dry. Today, the plant once more brings beauty to my office, but only after a period of renewal and waiting.

Psalm 121 comes to mind. The Psalmist asks from where his help will come. He answers that the help he desires will come only from God. "He who watches over you will not slumber. Indeed, he who watches over Israel will not slumber nor sleep. The Lord is your keeper. The Lord is your shade at your right hand. The sun will not harm you by day nor the moon by night. He will keep you from Evil, God will keep your life."

If you are feeling spiritually parched, return to the living water of Jesus. Drink deeply from the well God has prepared for us. Do not let yourself become spiritually dehydrated. Don't forget to pay attention to your faith. Desire a faith that is strong to provide you shade and comfort, strength, and vitality when you need it the most. Jesus told the woman at the well, "Whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life" (John 4:14).

Don't dry up this summer. Please, join us in worship----and don't forget to bring your bucket. Len


