From the Pastor

Many years ago, as Cathy and I were driving around Winston-Salem, we went by the house in which she lived as a little girl. When we drove by, she talked about how the house looked the same but kept commenting on how big the trees had grown. It has become an inside joke for us that whenever we return somewhere we once lived to comment on the size of the trees.

It is interesting that when we return to a place from our past, even knowing there will be changes, we are surprised by them; things are not the same. I felt this way the first time I drove by my grandparent's home in Gastonia. The garage was torn down and a second house was built where the garden once stood. The new owners had let the shrubs go untended. It was depressing to see what Granddaddy had taken such care of neglected. When we have a memory of something that memory doesn't change with the seasons, it remains unchanged. We expect things to be just like it was the last time we saw it. It isn't until we see it again that we see that time has affected those places too.

It occurs to me as we prepare to come back together as individual Sunday school classes etc. that over these last 18 plus months the trees have grown. There have been many changes among us that we will need to acknowledge. We will not be coming back to our classes; we will be moving forward into them. There have been events in people's lives that we may or may not have known about. Fifteen members of the church have passed away since we moved into COVID protocol. Some of our members have gone through difficult medical procedures. Some walk slower and some don't hear as well. Children have gotten taller, we have had two graduating classes, and there have been staff changes at church. We have grown stronger in these last months and we have grown older. We should expect the trees to be different.

For those who have not been together this last year and a half, there will be challenges. We have had people join the church. We may not remember names. Someone may be sitting on a favorite pew. It won't be like it once was. It is what God has directed and grown during the pandemic.

Did you know that during this time we have not failed to worship one single Sunday? Did you know that we have had Wednesday night Bible Study each week? Yes, these have been on the internet as have been Sunday school lessons, youth, and children's gatherings. Some have grown comfortable with these outlets, and it will take a while for them to return---we pray they will---and we know that some may never be able to. We will need to be patient with one another. We will need to share our stories and get reacquainted. This is normal. We have much to celebrate and things over which we need to grieve. We can't go back to how it was; we can only move forward to what it is.

See, just as we know trees will grow, we also know that until we see them, we can't fully imagine what they look like. Prayerfully, I think this is important to mention because if we don't acknowledge it, some may be disappointed and not know why. This is an important time to listen, to share, and to be open with the changes that have occurred in everyone's life. This is a time to practice hospitality not only to the stranger but also to the old friend we haven't seen in a while. God is doing remarkable things in us---and one of them may just be to see how big the trees have grown.




Handbell News
