### **Updated Worship Guidelines**

8/9/2021

At its recent meeting, the Diaconate held a lengthy discussion regarding how the Church needed to respond to the recent surge in COVID cases due to the Delta variant. After consideration of the input of numerous members, the Diaconate determined that the following updates to our current worship guidelines should be implemented:

- Individuals will be required to wear a mask while in the Church.
- Social distancing is always required while in the Church.
- The Choir will not perform or practice until further notice.
- Masks will be worn during the singing of hymns.
- Individual Sunday school classes will continue to meet, but mask wearing and social distancing is required while in the building. (Teachers may remove their mask during the lesson.)

We can all agree that this return to more restrictive guidelines is not what any of us wanted. However, until we see an improvement in vaccination rates and a downward trend in cases, the Diaconate did not feel it had any choice but to return to these more restrictive measures. Simply put, these steps have been taken to protect our church family and in particular, our most vulnerable adult members and our children, who are too young to be vaccinated. Thank you for your understanding and for your compliance with these changes.




