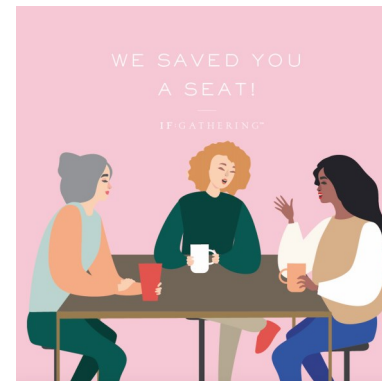
NEWS, ANNOUNCEMENTS, AND EVENTS
